Behold Your Mother

Standing by the cross of Jesus were his mother and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary of Magdala. When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple there whom he loved, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son." Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother." And from that hour the disciple took her into his home (John 19:25-27).

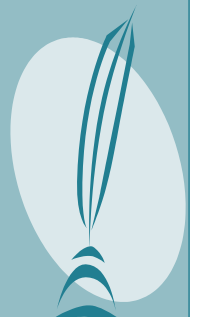
On Sunday, October 16, following the 10:45 am Mass, we will celebrate this reciprocal entrustment of ourselves to Mary- and her to us- when we consecrate our parish to her Immaculate Heart and bless and dedicate our new Marian Grotto.

Every journey starts with a single step. The pilgrimage to our Marian Grotto began with the youth over four years ago, when on retreat with Father Caesar they happened upon a grotto and prayed the rosary. It awakened a yearning – could we create a home for Mary here at Pax Christi, where all could go to be with their mother?

Through the generous contributions of many parishioners, it has been possible to create a simple, reverent, holy place to contemplate Our Mother in a special way. Cast life-size in bronze and centered on hand hewn stone, Our Mother is simply dressed and barefoot; her head is bent slightly downward. Here is the humble handmaid of the Lord. Mary bows low to welcome her little ones into open arms. She beckons us to be gathered safely under her mantle of protection. The statue is sited so that she gazes into the eyes of those kneeling and praying. Anchored and stable, children may climb into her lap for safety and learn of her grace.

All components of the grotto nurture prayer; Mary always directs us to her Son. Perennial flowers and grasses, shrubs and vines planted throughout give an awakening in Easter, color in summer, reflections in fall and hope for new beginnings at Christmas and through the winter. Leading into and throughout the grotto, are tumbled cobblestone pavers as a reminder of pilgrimage. Embedded within the pavers is a rosary- that sweet chain which links us to God- that may be walked. A trickle of water tumbles and flows nearby; font of life and reminder of tears shed. To provide shade in the summer heat and food in the fall, a large apple tree stands watchfully over Mary and her children.

Our Marian Grotto will be a place of peace, solitude, healing and prayer; a place where we may "be" with Our Mother, contemplate her Son, and experience the depths of His love. Please come and dwell in this holy place often.

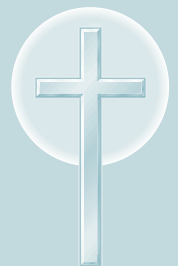
